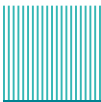

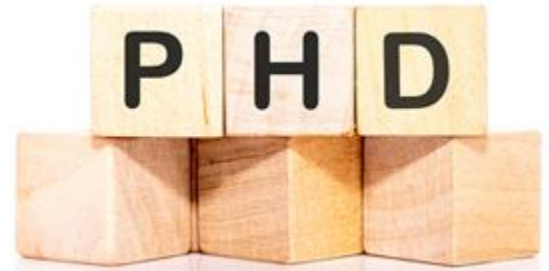

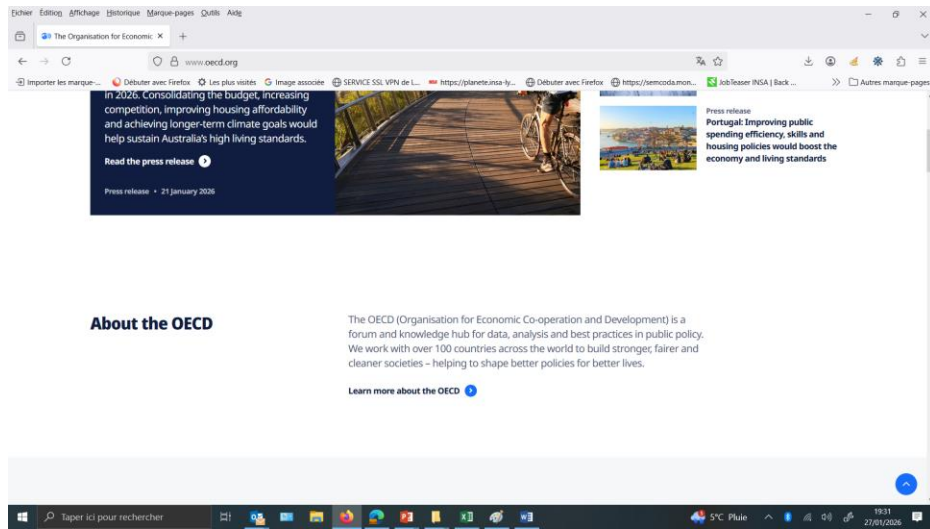


What is a PhD? – Key Facts

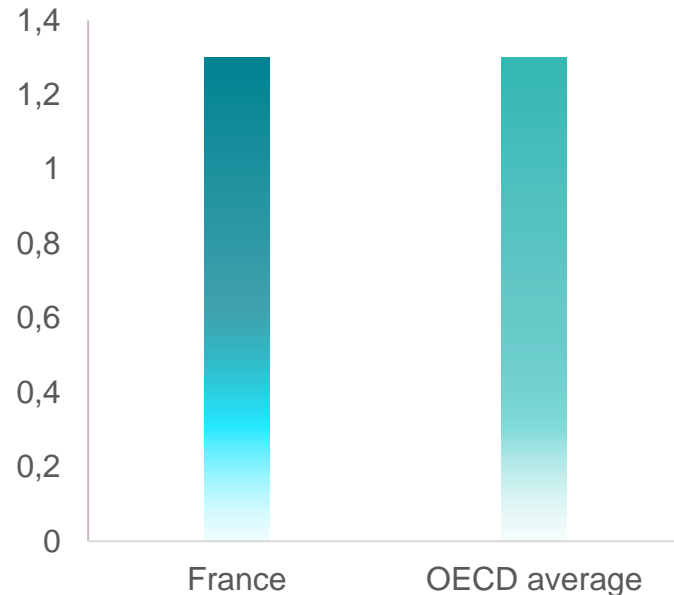
- Highest academic degree worldwide
- Full-time research project (3–4 years)
- Paid research position in most countries
- Original contribution to knowledge

France & OECD key figures:

- ~70,000 PhD candidates in France (2023)
- ~15,000 PhD degrees awarded each year
- ~1.3% of adults hold a PhD in OECD countries

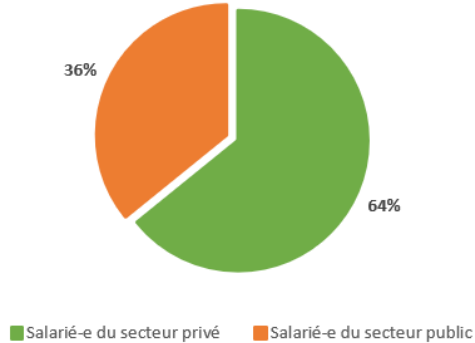


SHARE OF PHD HOLDERS (%)



Ph.D. studies: how and why?

Répartition secteur privé / secteur public



- ~36% of the Ph.D. awardees in **public academic research**, ~64% in **companies**
- 69% h. versus 31% f. in 2023/2024.
- **RNCP form** (National Registry of Professional Certification) : **acknowledgment of the specific skills** of Ph.D. holders, notably for **companies**

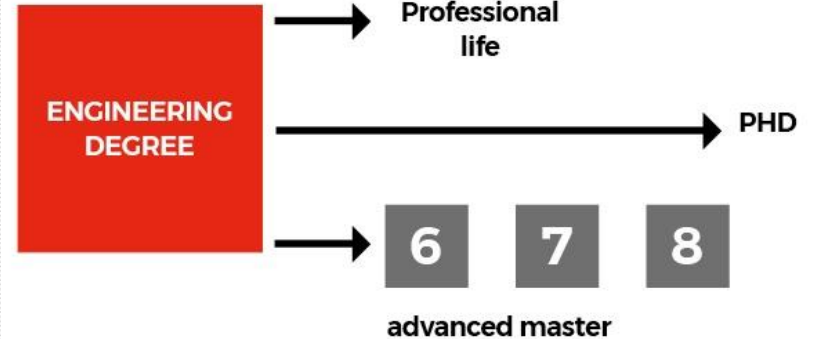
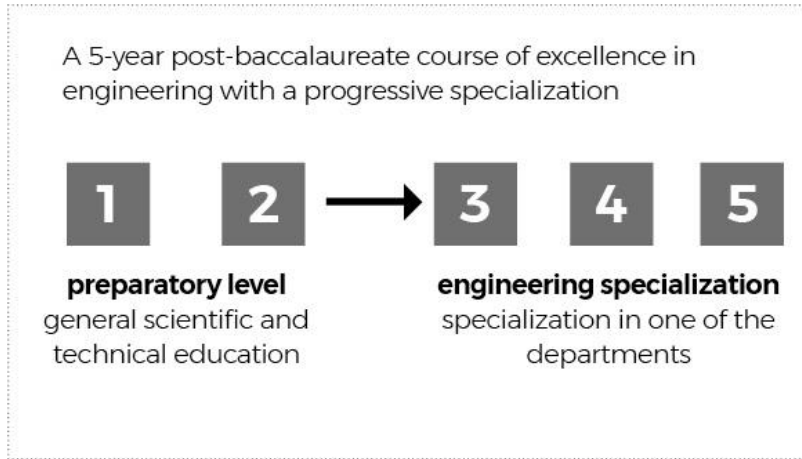
Update up to **15 February 2026** for (2021-2025)

- **Network aspects:** facilitated access to specific and big scientific that are mastered, and to sharp expertise

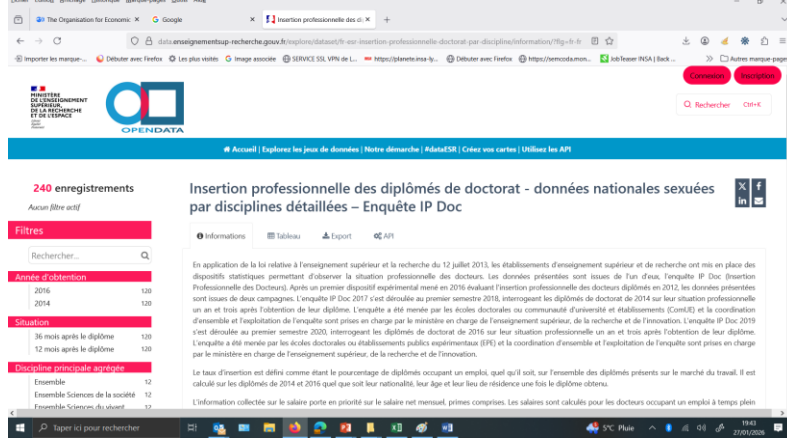

Professional insertion of PhD graduates in France (latest official data)

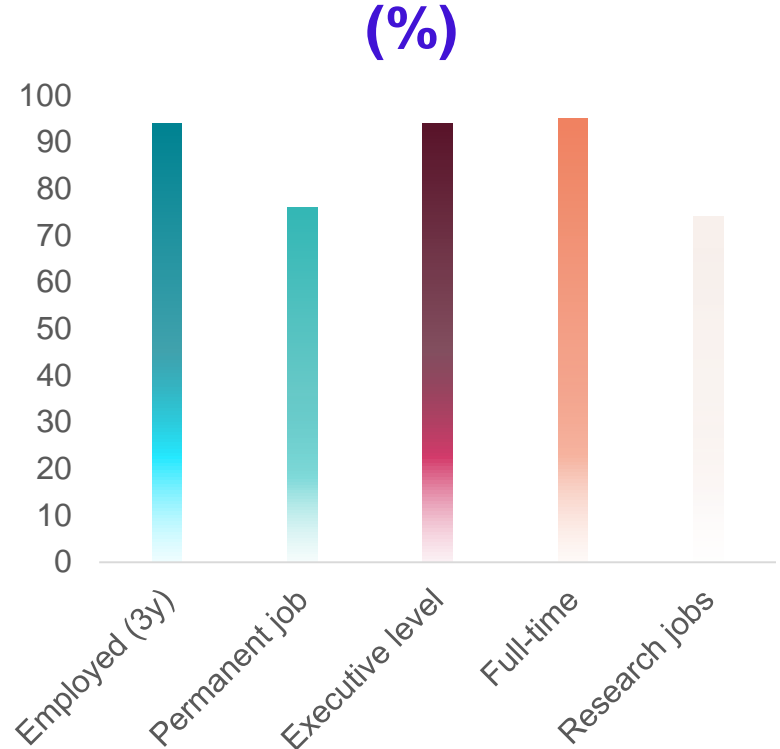


IPDoc national survey – PhD Class of 2020 (by MESR–SIES):

- 94% employed three years after graduation
- 76% in permanent positions (CDI or equivalent)
- 94% in executive-level positions
- 95% working full-time
- 74% of employed PhDs work in research (public or private)

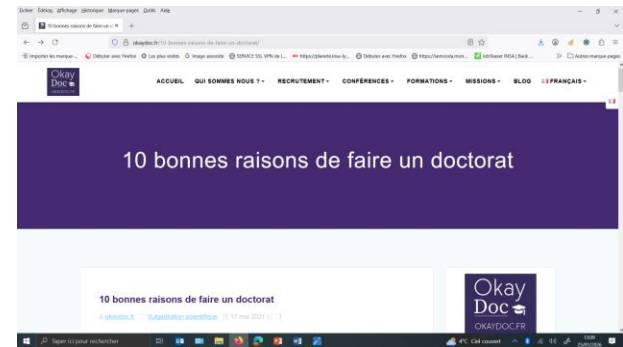

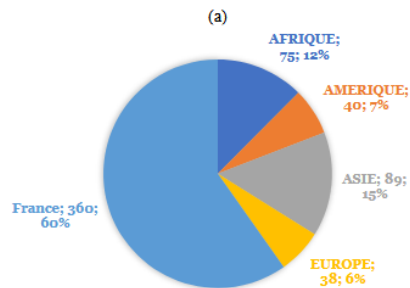
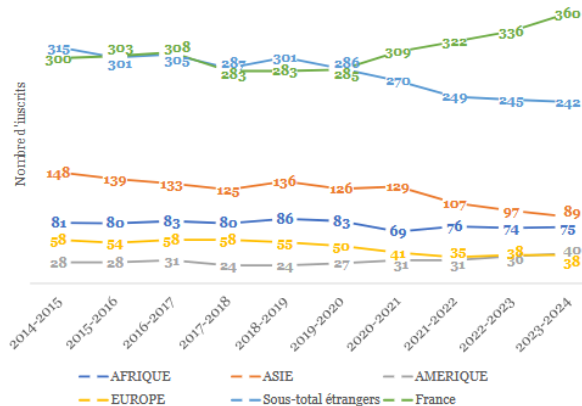

PhD framework in France – 2016 Decree

French Decree of 25 May 2016 – key principles:

Status:

- PhD candidate is a professional researcher-in-training
- Doctorate is a national degree recognized internationally

Funding:

- Mandatory funding for full-time PhD students
- Employment contract with full social protection

Training:

- Research-based training + transferable skills
- Career development and professional integration preparation

Supervision & quality assurance:

- Clear definition of supervisory responsibilities
- Individual monitoring committees (CSI)

Legal framework:

- Doctoral Charter signed by all parties
- National harmonization of doctoral standards

Open Science

- An open access article/book/manuscript is **more often downloaded, read and cited** (Gargouri et al. 2010 : <https://doi.org/10.1371/journal.pone.0013636>)
- It is also **better protected against plagiarism** because it is easily accessible by detection softwares
- They can easily be **integrated to job application proposal** (even before publication)
- Articles published in "classic" format (by subscription and not open access) are **copyrighted** by the publishers
 - They cannot be released until a **predefined embargo period** (available from **Sherpa-Romeo**: (<https://v2.sherpa.ac.uk/romeo/>))
- However « preprints » remain the **property of the authors**
 - Possibility **to deposit them and make them available**
 - Article 30 of the **Digital Republic Act**: maximum embargo of 6 months for STM (Sciences, Technics and Medicine)
- Doctorate Order of May 25th, 2016 (2022 Amendment):
 - « Under the responsibility of accredited institutions, the doctoral schools [...] **Raise awareness among PhD students of the challenges of open science and the dissemination of research work in society** to strengthen relations between scientists and citizens » (translated)

Open Science

- OS platform:
 - **Public, non-profit: HAL...**
- Social networks that may host documents:
 - Private, usually for-profit: ResearchGate
 - The latter are particularly unpopular among publishers!
- The notion of Open Science also applies to **data**: <https://www.ouvrirlascience.fr/recherche-data-gouv-plateforme-nationale-federee-des-donnees-de-la-recherche/>
- Except in cases of force majeure, theses must be submitted on an open site
 - <https://theses.insa-lyon.fr/>
 - <https://theses.hal.science/INSA-LYON-THESES>



- OS roadmap voted on by the INSA Administrative Council: in 2024, **100% of PhD students starting a defense procedure must have an IdHAL, with their publications on the platform.**

Several training courses are available throughout the year.

▪ PEPS DOC

Doctoral training seminar: “Promoting and Exploring Professional Skills in Doctoral Studies” Currently being redesigned with one team of doctoral students and another team of supervisors.

▪ Formation à l'Activité Complémentaire d'Enseignement

In order to support them as they enter the teaching profession, INSA Lyon doctoral students who are teaching while preparing their thesis and who may become teacher-researchers in the future can take a course in university teaching.

This training, lasting a total of 20 hours, is provided by INSA Lyon's “Athena” Teaching, Digital and Learning Techniques Support team and is scheduled over three sessions between the first and second years of the thesis.

Open science in engineering

Open science is a fundamental component of the dialogue between science and society. It also safeguards the work of researchers (for example, by providing greater robustness against the risk of plagiarism). In addition to the training offered at the site level, INSA offers training on open science in areas specific to engineering professions. The following topics are covered during this seminar

French as a Foreign Language (FLE)

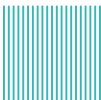
Each academic year, the French as a Foreign Language (FLE) department at INSA Lyon's Humanities Center offers doctoral students (enrolled at INSA exclusively) the opportunity to enroll in a French course lasting two hours per week (four hours for beginners). This course begins in November and ends in May, and takes place in the evening (6pm to 8pm).

Supervisors seminar

Supervising doctoral students is both a scientific and human adventure! It requires supervisors to constantly adapt to changes in the challenges and maturity of young researchers throughout their studies. This new seminar aims to analyze and better understand the specific mechanisms at work in the development of the relationship between supervisors and doctoral students.

In a small group (max. 12 people), emphasizing diversity of experience, participants will explore their practice through the regular contribution of models of action and management, as well as interpretation grids, enriched with concrete examples from the participants. Each participant will also be able to choose their own theme for experimentation according to their needs.

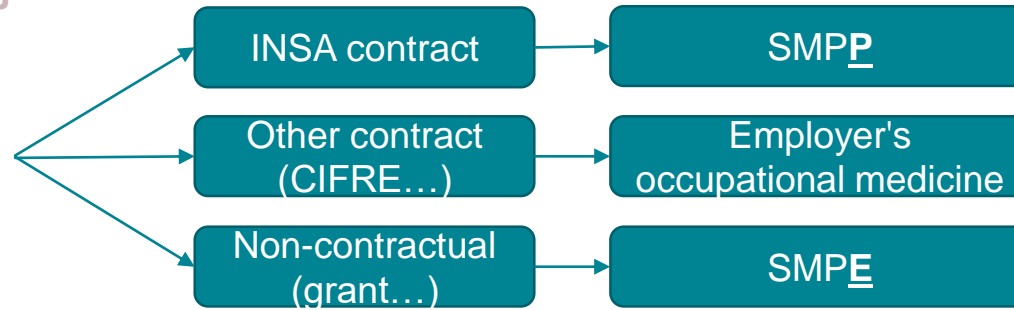

Focus: Medical surveillance of contractual doctoral students

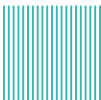
- **Medical visit at hiring** within 3 months
- **For all Ph.D. students: BIENNIAL specific medical follow-up**
- **Specific ANNUAL medical follow-up**
 - If **disability**
 - If **pregnant**, recently given birth or breastfeeding
 - If **reinstated** after long-term sick leave or long-term leave
 - Or suffering from **specific pathologies** determined by the institute medical service
 - **Pre-reinstatement visit** if there is a risk of difficulties at the position during the reinstatement
- **Reinstatement visit** organized within 8 days, after a leave of more than 30 days.
- **Visit at the request of the Ph.D. student** if difficulties at work in relation to health or work problems impacting health
- **Visit at the request of the employer** to verify the adequacy of the member's health to his or her position.
- **Visit at the request of the medical service**



Focus: Medical surveillance of Ph.D. students

During the work health visit

- Bring **your vaccination record and glasses**
- **The individual exposure form (FIE)** to risks
 - ACD-CMR: Hazardous Chemical Agents CMR
 - ROA : Artificial Optical Radiation
 - RI : Ionizing radiation
 - This form must be signed by the Director of the unit (lab) and kept by the unit and the Ph.D. student
- **Additional examinations are carried out during the visit:** visual tests, hearing tests, urine tests in the context of public health and health at work.
- **Prescription of additional** examinations covered by the INSA
 - If exposed to chemical hazards: **biological assessment**
 - If exposed to the laser risk class 3 or 4: **ophthalmological assessment**
 - Other examinations based on occupational exposures

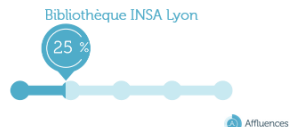

Background

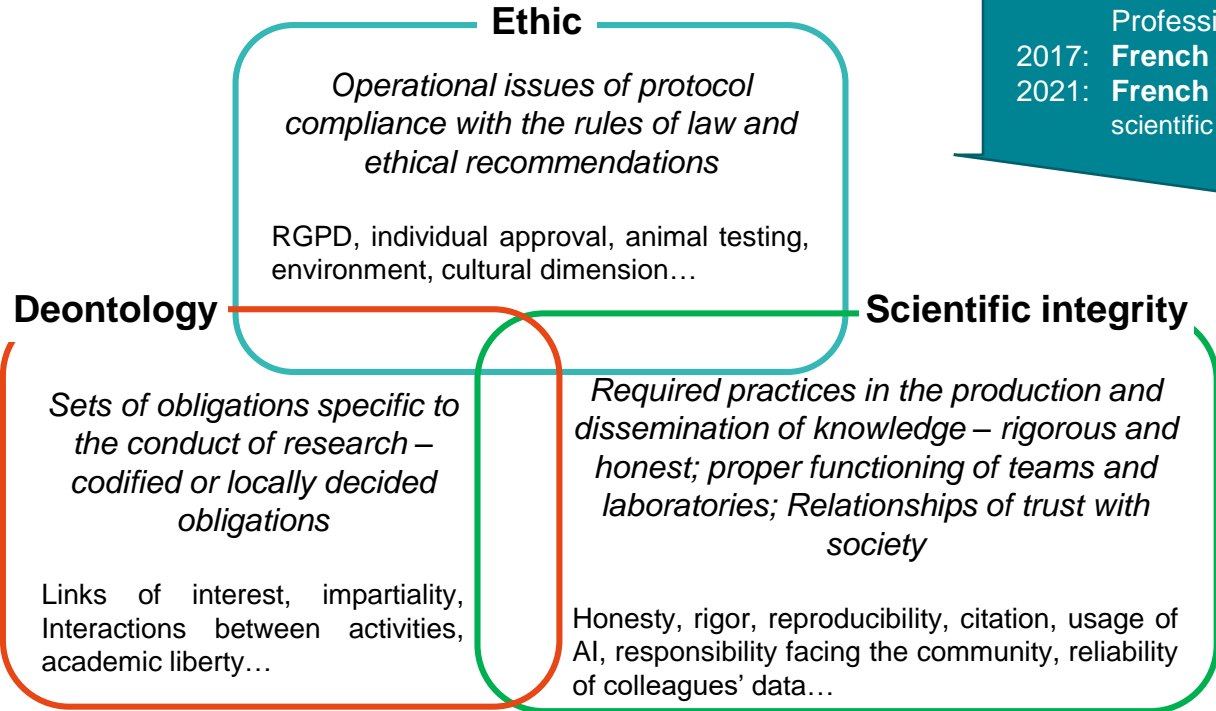
Present angiotensin-converting-enzyme inhibitor treatment fails to prevent progression of non-diabetic renal disease. 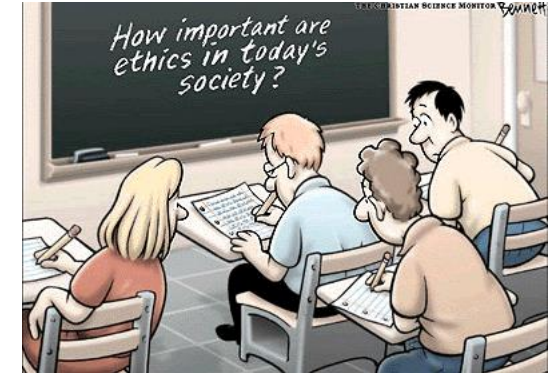

Scientific Integrity: Background



2005: **European Charter of researchers**
2010: **Singapore Declaration on Research Integrity**
2015: **1st National Charter of Ethics for Research Professions**
2017: **French Office of Scientific Integrity (OFIS)**
2021: **French Decree** relative to the requirements of scientific integrity by public institutions and foundations

- INSA Lyon (and by extension its staff and students) is **signatory** of the **French Charter of Ethics for Research Professions** and of the **European Code of Conduct for Research Integrity** (ALLEA, 2018)



- **Plagiarism: often the consequence of negligence**
→ Learn to:
 - Cite the sources: « *citation* » and citation reference (+ bibliographic management software)

- **Oath of scientific integrity**, included in the French Research Code and Law

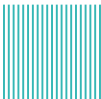

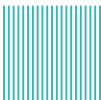

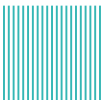
